1. Bachelor's degree

The BA programme in **Intercultural Communication** belongs to the Class of Degrees in Communication Sciences (L-20), lasts three years and involves the acquisition of 180 university credits (CFU/ECTS) to obtain the title.

The Degree Course aims to provide a solid basic cultural and methodological preparation in different areas in the **linguistic**, **philosophical-literary**, **socio-anthropological**, **psycho-pedagogical**, **business organization**, as well as in a **non-European language** (Arabic, Chinese or Japanese), which will allow graduates to achieve transversal knowledge and the ability to critically analyze the **main aspects of communication**, the complexity of communication processes and the diversity of communication models in an intercultural perspective.

ELECTIVE COURSES 12 CFU

The degree course offers the possibility of having 12 credits as free credits, to be achieved during the third year. These 12 credits can gather from: 1) internship (see slide 6); 2) Erasmus (slide 9); 3) course(s) of your choice.

Regarding the course(s) of your choice, in addition to the courses of the "Riccardo Massa" Department of Human Sciences for Education, you can also choose exams from other departments of the University (if they are coherent to your university career).

If the student is interested in learning more about the topics of an Intercultural Communication course (for example the culture of the language being studied or any other course, excluding language courses), it is possible to make one or more courses biannual, after contacting the teacher of reference and having agreed together the program and bibliography to bring to the exam.

NB: it is not enough to include the course in the study plan, you MUST NECESSARILY agree the program with the relevant teacher before doing the exam.



INTERNSHIP 6 CFU

In their third year, students can work as interns at Institutions, Companies or Associations with which the University as established an agreement.

Such activities, if coherent with the occupational roles stated in the BA guidelines, can be awarded 6 CFU. The internship must be carried out for at least 150 hours/2 months.




Social networks

UniMiB Course: useful to look up info such as class schedule, exams, updates on time/dates of either exams or classes. Students can book an open seat through this App.



How does it work?



Rosetta Stone is an advanced language platform open to students, lecturers and technical and administrative staff of the University of Milano-Bicocca, offering online courses ranging from "beginner" (A1) to "expert" (C1) level. A test identifies initial linguistic ability of each user.

At the end of the test, Rosetta suggests a number of areas to focus on during the course. We recommend to select all the areas to have them available all the time. The different areas allow to refine a specific linguistic register - legal, medical, financial, sport etc. - and to find subjects, passages of

150-hours collaboration

Students can apply for 150-hours collaboration calls and work part-time within Campus; it has a 150-hours/academic year limit.

Scholarship

Fees and funding

University fees for students enrolled on Bachelor's, Master's and Single Cycle Master's degree programmes are divided into two instalments of different amounts and with different payment deadlines:

- the first, corresponding to the minimum amount, is the same for all students
- the second technically referred to as an 'all-inclusive fee'- that is variable.

In order to facilitate international student enrolment to the Master's Degrees entirely taught in English, for all students with first non-Italian citizenship and with a qualification obtained abroad, the University of Milano – Bicocca has provided for:

- a single contribution for enrolment in the first year of 0 €;
- a single contribution of 600€ for enrolment in any academic year following the first for Marine Sciences, Materials Science, Science of Medicine and Surgery, and € 500 for International Economics and Applied Experimental Psychological Sciences.

The University makes every effort to provide a fees, funding and scholarship search facility that is helpful and reliable for prospective and current students


